This week, attendance is currently at 92.4% which is well below our target. As parents will be aware from the media, there is a huge emphasis on improving school attendance. Research has shown that Good Attendance is important because children are more likely to succeed in their learning when they attend school consistently. It is difficult for the teacher and the pupil to build their skills and progress if they are absent. Please help us achieve our target of 95.7% at all times.

Can I remind everyone that holidays will only be authorised if your child's attendance for the 12 months prior to the holiday application is over 95% and stays above 95% to the date of travel.

National Tests

It is essential that your child is in School every day during this period. **No** holidays will be authorised during this period.
