This week, attendance is currently at 95.6%. Research has shown that there is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement. We have been instructed to ask for medical evidence if a child is absent from school whose attendance levels is cause for concern. Without medical evidence from your doctor or the hospital your child will be given an unauthorised mark and letters will be sent out to families whose attendance levels are cause for concern. Please make every effort to ensure that your child is in school unless they are genuinely ill and unable to attend school. Please help us achieve our target of 95.7% at all times.



## **National Tests**

We are all so proud of our pupils in Years 2 to 6 who have sat their National Tests in Reading and Reasoning (applying their maths knowledge to solve problems). This week they have all worked really hard and approached their tests with confidence. The data will be sent to the Welsh Government and results will be given out with your child's end of year report in July.

Over the coming weeks, the pupils in Years 2 to 6 will sit an online test in Procedural maths in school. Once they have sat this test, assessments will be available for you to access online. We will inform you of the dates when they are available within the next few weeks.




Homework is sent home with our pupils every week.
