The Council has recently received reports that parents are being targeted for nonpayment of fixed penalty notices for unauthorised child absences. This is type of scam is known as 'Mandate Fraud'.

Parents must remain <u>VIGILANT</u> when receiving unsolicited telephone calls where financial information or a payment is required. Council officers who deal with the attempted recovery of fixed penalties for unauthorised child absence will <u>NOT</u> telephone parents asking for payment. The recovery of penalties such as these are done so by written correspondence only.
