This week, attendance is currently 95%. Our target is 95.7%.

School attendance remains a key priority for us as a school and Rhondda Cynon Taf as an LEA so that we can ensure that all learners are safeguarded and have the best possible opportunities of achieving success throughout their education.

We have been visited by the Attendance and Wellbeing service who monitor our attendance levels. We have been instructed to ask for medical evidence if a child is absent from school whose attendance levels is cause for concern. Without medical evidence from your doctor or the hospital your child will be given an unauthorised mark.

Please make every effort to ensure that your child is in school unless they are genuinely ill and unable to attend. Even if your child wakes up poorly but is fine later on, they should still come to school. Also, if they have been ill and are better by Friday please bring them to school as every day is important.

The next phase of co-construction is to seek the views of the whole education profession, children and young people, and parents/carers, as well as all other interested stakeholders and partners. This affords the opportunity for everyone to engage with *Curriculum for Wales 2022 guidance*, give feedback on what has been developed and provide suggestions for refinement. The feedback phase will conclude on 19 July 2019 and the feedback will be considered by education professionals involved in its development. *Curriculum for Wales 2022 guidance* will then be refined before it is made available in January 2020 for rollout in September 2022 for all year groups in primary school and Year 7 in secondary schools. The curriculum will roll out to Year 8 in September 2023 and year on year until it is introduced to Year 11 in 2026.


The class structure for the next academic year is provided below.
