School attendance remains a key priority for us as a school and Rhondda Cynon Taf as an LEA so that we can ensure that all learners are safeguarded and have the best possible opportunities of achieving success throughout their education.

We have been visited by the Attendance and Wellbeing service who monitor our attendance levels. We have been instructed to ask for medical evidence if a child is absent from school whose attendance levels is cause for concern. Without medical evidence from your doctor or the hospital your child will be given an unauthorised mark.

Please make every effort to ensure that your child is in school unless they are genuinely ill and unable to attend. Even if your child wakes up poorly but is fine later on, they should still come to school. Also, if they have been ill and are better by Friday please bring them to school as every day is important.

Dinners

There is a new menu which has been running from

Monday, September 9th 2019. The menu runs on a two week cycle. Each day children in years 2 to 6 can have the choice between two different meals.

In addition, at Rhigos Primary children in years 2 to 6 can put in an 'order' at the start of the school day. They can choose from jacket potatoes; wraps; pasta pot; sandwich with a filling that is on the menu on the day which could be ham, tuna, cheese, salmon or chicken.

Dinners cost £2.50 paid daily or £12.50 a week payable on a Monday for the week ahead.

Copies of the menu are available from the school office and are displayed in and outside the hall.
