Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the decision of the Welsh Government all primary school learners will to return to school from 15th March. We look forward to welcoming Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Monday, March 15th 2021.

There will be a member of staff on duty from 8:45am and children will be able to go directly to their classes. At home time, the gates will be open from 3:15pm. All visitors to the school must wear a face covering and maintain social distancing of 2 metres.

We have all worked very hard to ensure our schools are as safe as possible. **Cwm Taf Morgannwg Health Authority** have stressed the importance of parents and the community playing their part in controlling the spread of the virus once children are again attending school by:

Not having other children to your home to play, even outdoors, and even if they are in the same bubble at school.

Not sharing a lift to school or other activities from other parents unless absolutely necessary.

Keeping your distance from other parents, and not hanging around to chat when you take and fetch your child to and from school.

Making sure your child understands the importance of washing their hands regularly. Keeping your child at home if they are unwell, even if you are

<u>School Uniform</u>


Please can all children wear school uniform except on their PE days where they can wear their PE kits to school.
