What to do if your child develops symptoms

Please be aware of possible symptoms of coronavirus during this period. The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

fever (greater than 37.8°C)

new persistent/continuous cough; and/or loss or change in sense of taste or smell.

If anyone in your household develops any of these symptoms, however mild, they need to stay at home and must follow the guidance;

# Please also remember general public health measures to reduce the risk of infection in our community by:

Staying at home as much as possible.
