


# <u>Inset days</u>

#### Arrangements for Next Term

We have been informed by RCT that for the time being the procedures that we have currently have in place will remain in September such as social distancing, face masks on school grounds and the one-way system.

From RCT and WG:

It must, however, be recognised that the COVID situation remains uncertain, and there may be a need to issue further updates in the event of any significant developments during the summer holiday period. In these circumstances, Welsh Government intend to work with stakeholders to consider how best to provide schools and settings with the time required to make any necessary adjustments to mitigations at the start of term (including any enhancements should these be judged necessary and proportionate to ensure safety at that time).

Visitors to the school setting should use a face covering, including parents/carers when dropping off and picking up learners.

The only change at the moment is that the school drop off and pick up times will revert back to pre-pandemic times i.e.:

Nursery to Year 1 children will be picked up at 3.20pm

Years 2 - to Year 6 can be collected at 3.30pm.

Children can be dropped off at school from 8:45 where there will be a teacher on duty.

All children should be in school for a prompt start of 8.55.

We have been informed that Breakfast Club will still be on a 'capped' basis for the Autumn term. If your child has a place then the gates for Breakfast Club will be open from 8.10 to 8.30am.

No doubt there will be further information throughout the summer holidays and I will contact you closer to the start of the new year.

Thank you for what has been a very challenging year and in many, many ways a lovely year working with the children and the community. I would like to thank the staff and Governors for their support this year. They have been amazing and have kept the school 'normal' in so many ways. Diolch yn fawr.

May I wish you all on behalf of all at Rhigos Primary a safe and peaceful summer holidays and we look forward to seeing all the children back at school on Monday, September 6<sup>th</sup> 2021.
