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<u>Missed Nasal Flu Vaccine</u>

We have received this message from Cwm Taf Morgannwg Public Health Team

Due to COVID 19 circulating within our communities, many children have missed their nasal flu vaccine in school this year. In order to offer these children an additional opportunity for flu vaccination we are holding walk-in Nasal Flu vaccination sessions for all children aged 2 to Year 11 who have missed their school session.

These sessions will be held at our 5 Community Vaccination Centres on the 22nd and 23rd January 2022 09.00–16.00.

Guidance from RCT/WG:

Please note that:

- 1. People who are un-vaccinated contacts of positive cases and are self-isolating for 10 days should now take a lateral flow test on day two and day eight instead of a PCR test. This will help to increase PCR testing capacity.
- 2.If a person showing no symptoms has a positive lateral flow test they will no longer be advised to have a follow-up PCR test to confirm the result, unless they are in a clinically vulnerable group, which may need early access to treatment or have been advised to do so as part of a research or surveillance programme. They should still follow self isolating rules.
 - 3. Anyone with COVID (respiratory illness) symptoms should still get a PCR test and not use an LFT.
