Latest Updated Guidance from RCT/WG:

Please note that:

1. People who are un-vaccinated contacts of positive cases and are self-isolating for 10 days should now take a lateral flow test on day two and day eight instead of a PCR test. This will help to increase PCR testing capacity. This change will come into effect immediately.
2. If a person showing no symptoms has a positive lateral flow test they will no longer be advised to have a follow-up PCR test to confirm the result, unless they are in a clinically vulnerable group, which may need early access to treatment or have been advised to do so as part of a research or surveillance programme. They should still follow self isolating rules.
3. Anyone with COVID (respiratory illness) symptoms should still get a PCR test and not use an LFD test.
