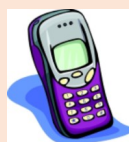


As we continually update our records please could you inform us of any **NEW** allergies that your child may have.

Please could all entries be emailed by 12pm on Monday, February 28<sup>th</sup> 2022 so that there is time for them to be judged.

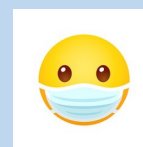
If you require further information please contact the school or see your child's class teacher.
