We are selling red noses £1.50 each for this deserving cause.



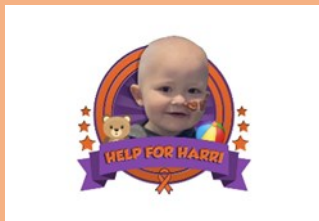

ONLINE DINNER PAYMENTS

We have received the following message from RCT to share with you:

In order to meet mandatory payment industry requirements the Council's online payment system has been enabled for 3DSV2 authentication. This means that payments will be subject to more stringent security checks. As a result the wait time has increased on the 'Authenticating payer details' screen. Please see screen image below.

The message displayed has been amended to indicate payers need to allow up to 15 seconds before selecting submit. If payers click submit in less than 15 seconds the payment will fail. We have been made aware of instances of payment failure. In the event of payers contacting schools when having difficulty paying, we would be grateful if you could communicate the requirement to allow up to 15 seconds as directed on the screen.

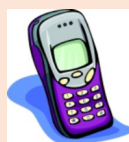


As we continually update our records please could you inform us of any **NEW** allergies that your child may have.
