A big thank you to all of our Breakfast Club who we know do a brilliant job and it is just nice to have this recognition.

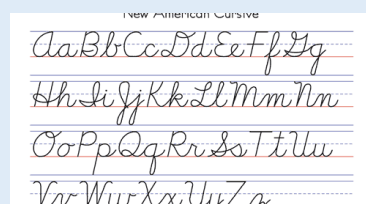


Dear parents and carers,

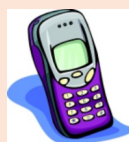


As we continually update our records please could you inform us of any **NEW** allergies that your child may have.
