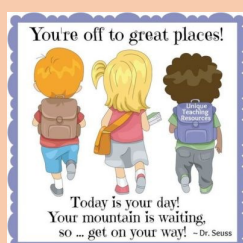

The school nurse will be here on Tuesday 4th October to administer the nasal flu vaccine to all consenting pupils.



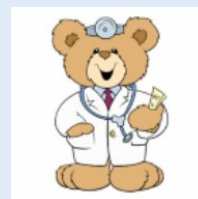
Holidays in term time
