



PCSO Visit

Mollie and Riley reported the following:

Carys and Katy, our PCSOs (Police Community Support Officers) visited our class yesterday to talk to us about keeping safe on Hallowe'en and Bonfire Night.

They talked to us about keeping safe such as:

- .not to going out on our own
- .always tell an adult where you are going before you go
- .take a phone with you
- .never go into someone's house when you are trick or treating
- .never go near fire works
- .take care of your pets
- .if there is a 'Do not knock' sticker on the door do not knock and go on to next house
- .wear gloves for sparklers
- .stay well away from fireworks and bonfires

Holidays in term time

Can I remind everyone that holidays will only be authorised if your child's attendance for the 12 months prior to the holiday application is over 95% and stays above 95% to the date of travel.



Road Safety

In the interest of safety for all our children please do not park on the yellow lines in front of the school and from parking on the pavement opposite the entrance of the school. With poor visibility during bad weather crossing the road becomes very hazardous when the traffic is increased at the start and the end of the school day.

Absence messages

Following a monitoring meeting with RCT's Attendance and Wellbeing Service, if your child is unwell medical evidence is required otherwise the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
