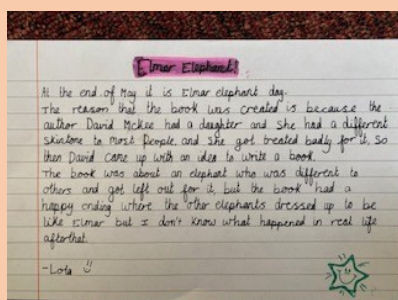
Toddler Group

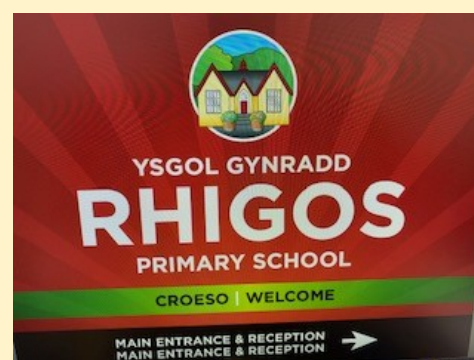
