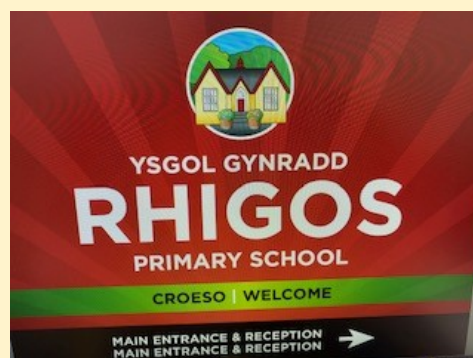

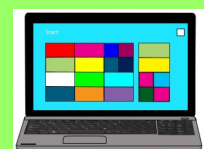
Thank you for all your donations. RCT will visit the school to weigh and collate the results.

They reported:



Class 1 : have been learning about planting and how they grow. They have been measuring objects using cubes and discussing sizes. They have been creating their own flower pictures using different media.

Sophia said, that she enjoyed counting cubes and so did Layla !!

Class 2: have been measuring in millilitres and litres. In English they are learning about adjectives, verbs, adverbs and nouns. In topic they are looking at internet safety..

Class 3: have been doing geometry in maths and also drawing graphs using SALT (which means scale; axis; lab and title). They have also been learning about plants and how they survive and grow. In Welsh they have a new game called, 'Gem Yr Dice'.
