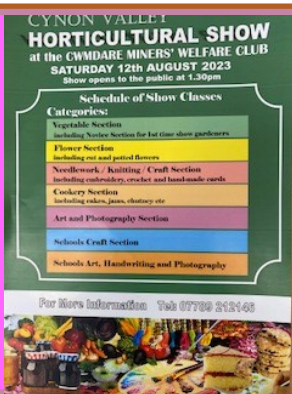

Sun Lotion

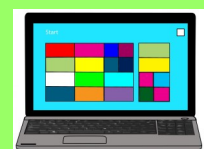
