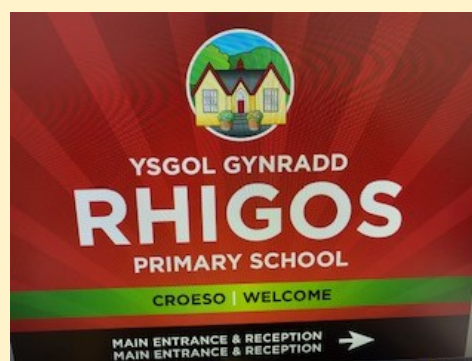

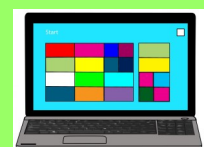


Please could children bring their reading books every day to school.
