

Dear Parent/Guardian.

Phased rollout of Primary Free School Meals for the youngest children from September 2022 onwards

From the new autumn term (Monday 5^{th} September 2022) onwards all Reception children will be offered Free School Meals. From 1^{st} January 2023 all Year 1 children will receive this offer and Year 2 children will receive the offer from 1^{st} April 2023. We will be in further communication as the offer is rolled out. This is an important step in reaching the shared ambition of ensuring no child goes hungry while in school.

In response to the current rising cost-of-living, Welsh Government and Rhondda Cynon Taf CBC are committed to implementing this scheme quickly and would ask for your patience as we build catering capacity to ensure a successful phased implementation and work towards a whole school roll-out over the next three years.

In order for the council to prepare and cater for numbers, we would be very grateful if you would kindly complete the following and $\frac{\text{return by Monday } 11^{\text{th}} \text{ July }}{2022}$ -

Holidays in term time

Can I remind everyone that holidays will only be authorised if your child's attendance for the 12 months prior to the holiday application is over 95% and stays above 95% to the date of travel.



Road Safety

In the interest of safety for all our children please do not park on the yellow lines in front of the school and from parking on the pavement opposite the entrance of the school. With poor visibility during bad weather crossing the road becomes very hazardous when the traffic is increased at the start and the end of the school day.

Absence messages

When your child is absent from school a message should be left on the school phone informing us of the illness.



Unfortunately saying "unwell" is not acceptable by the Attendance and Wellbeing Service, so we ask for your support in that a more detailed explanation is given.

If your child has any appointments please provide us with the official letter for our records.

As we continually update our records please could you inform us of any NEW allergies that your child may have.

Please can you notify the school of any change of address or contact details as soon as any changes are made for your child.



Please could children bring their reading books every day to school.



Ready for School in Warmer Weather

As we are moving into summer time please could you ensure that your child is protected from the sun with sun screen. Also, a sun hat and a water bottle is advisable. Please can we kindly ask that your child comes to school (and PE days) in school uniform - summer dress/shorts; white t-shirt; black shorts.
