July 22nd - **Inset** - school closed to pupils



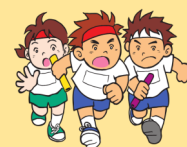
Leavers' Concert

Your child will come home with a letter with just a few final arrangements. Please can children be in school promptly at 8.45 on Tuesday of the trip.

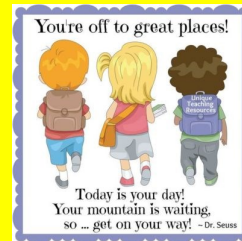

£1.00 weekly and refreshments are available.



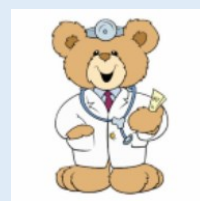
Holidays in term time

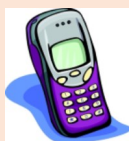


As we continually update our records please could you inform us of any **NEW** allergies that your child may have.
